Fond du Lac County Opioid Initiative is holding a Free Community Narcan Training

The Opioid Initiative of Drug Free Communities of Fond du Lac County (DFC) is a coalition of community partners working together to reduce the negative impact of opioids in the county. The Harm Reduction Pillar of DFC's Opioid Initiative is partnering with the AIDS Resource Center of WI (ARCW) to provide free Narcan trainings. These trainings are for anyone who is affected by opioid use, including individuals who use, friends and family members of individuals who use, and people who work with individuals who use opioids.

At the trainings, learn how to respond and safely use Narcan, a medication that can reverse an opioid overdose that may occur if using heroin or prescription pain medication. At the trainings you will receive a free Narcan Kit, which includes two doses of Narcan. The Narcan trainings are a non-judgmental, safe space where community members can remain anonymous. RSVP is not required.
