Did You Know? It only takes a small amount of nicotine to poison a child:



- **Swallowing** as little as $\frac{1}{2}$ of a teaspoon of liquid nicotine can be **deadly** to a small child.
- **Touching** liquid nicotine is **easily absorbed** through the skin.
- **Eating Tobacco** nicotine is highly toxic. As little as **1 milligram (mg)** of nicotine, **a very small amount** can cause symptoms in an **infant**.

A single bottle of liquid nicotine can contain **24mg** of nicotine.

A single cigarette can have **10-20** mg of nicotine.

While one cigarette butt contains **5 - 7** mg.

Symptoms of Poisoning

- Severe stomach pain
- Vomiting
- seizures
- Fast heart rate
