Public Involvement & Participation Strategy

The purpose of the Fond du Lac County Stormwater Information & Education Plan is to inform and train county employees on issues related to the construction, modification and maintenance of county owned stormwater management systems within the Fond du Lac Urbanized Area as defined by the 2000 U.S. Census. This urbanized area map is being modified by Fond du Lac County to include land areas adjacent to the Urbanized Area that contain urbanized development draining into the mapped urbanized area. A map of the urbanized area is attached to this document. A modified urbanized area map will be included at a later date upon completion of map modifications.

Given the purpose of the Fond du Lac County Stormwater Information & Education Plan, the County's public involvement and participation strategy is as follows:

- Distribute draft of the Fond du Lac County Stormwater Information and Education Plan to appropriate County departments and the DNR for review and comment. January 2009.
- Before adoption of the Fond du Lac County Stormwater Information and Education Plan, hold a public hearing with the Extension Education, Agriculture, and Recreation Committee of the Fond du Lac County Board of Supervisors. February 2009.
- Incorporate public and employee comments into the Plan as appropriate before adoption by the Fond du Lac County Board of Supervisors. February 2009.
- Adoption of the Plan by the Fond du Lac County Board of Supervisors. February 2009.
- Post the Fond du Lac County Stormwater Information and Education Plan on the County web page for public viewing. Provide an email link to facilitate further public comments or questions. Keep a log of email inquiries and responses for each calendar year. March 2009.
- Post the Fond du Lac County Stormwater Information and Education Plan for public viewing at the County Clerk's Office and at county departments with direct county owned stormwater facilities including the Fairgrounds, County Airport, County Highway Department, Rolling Meadows Golf Course, Central Maintenance, Planning & Parks, and the Land Conservation Office.
- Distribute the Fond du Lac County Stormwater Information and Education Plan to all effected County departments. March 2009.
- Distribute the Fond du Lac County Stormwater Information and Education Plan to cities, villages, and towns within the modified urbanized area. March 2009.
- Hold briefings on county stormwater management issues at quarterly county department head meetings. Document with minutes and written follow-ups as necessary. January, April, August, October of each calendar year.
- Discuss county stormwater management issues and decide on appropriate actions at quarterly county sub-department head meetings. Document with minutes and written follow-ups as necessary. March, June, September, December of each calendar year.
