

OFFICE HOURS


Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays

CARE CLINIC HEALTH SERVICES

The Fond du Lac County Care Clinic provides exclusive services for Fond du Lac County employees and their families. The clinic is open 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday. Call (920) 926-5676 to schedule an appointment. Please arrive 15 to 20 minutes prior to your appointment to park and complete any necessary paperwork. If you arrive more than 10 minutes late, you may need to reschedule your appointment.

If you need to cancel or reschedule an appointment, please notify us as far in advance as possible so that your time may be given to another patient in need of care.

As an added Fond du Lac County benefit, you can utilize the Agnesian Convenient Care Clinic, located at 145 N. Main Street, Fond du Lac, on Saturdays and Sundays with Care Clinic benefits. Please mention that you have Fond du Lac County insurance when registering.
