



COVID-19 Data by Municipality Summary

August 26, 2020

Summary

- According to [WI DHS](#), currently in Fond du Lac County the burden of confirmed COVID-19 cases is high and the activity level is high. This is based on COVID-19 data from the last 2 weeks.
- As reported by WI DHS as of 8/26/2020, the past 2-week confirmed case rate for Fond du lac County is 300 per 100,000 population, an increase from the 223.5 per 100,000 population case rate reported last week on 8/19/2020.
- Unusually high case rates, in part, due to small population sizes, were noted in the past two weeks for several municipalities.
- Increased physical distancing and mask wearing are recommended to reduce case counts and decrease spread of the virus. Keep social circles small and avoid crowded indoor spaces.

Background Information and Considerations

This report provides data on the confirmed COVID-19 cases from August 10 - August 23, 2020 for municipalities located within the Fond du Lac County Health Department jurisdiction. Data may be underreported for recent days because results can take multiple days to be reported to the health department. As this is a weekly report for the past 14 days, there will always be a week of overlap between reports.

The COVID-19 data provided in this report is specific to the Fond du Lac County Health Department (FCHD) jurisdiction (population: 103,403). It does not include data or cases for the portions of municipalities that fall outside of Fond du Lac County, such as the City of Waupun. FCHD only provides case counts, case rates, and burden status based on the jurisdiction of Fond du Lac County. Case rates fluctuate greatly among municipalities with small population sizes. Interpret case rates with caution.

Burden Status	Case Rate per 100,000 residents in the past two weeks
Low	Case rate is less than or equal to 10.
Moderate	Case rate is greater than 10, but less than or equal to 50.
Moderately High	Case rate is greater than 50, but less than or equal to 100.
High	Case rate is greater than 100.

Note: Case rate is determined by number of new confirmed cases during the past two weeks, divided by population in the municipality, multiplied by 100,000. Rates can fluctuate greatly with small population sizes making it difficult to call out high rates. The number of cases for each burden status refers to the number of confirmed cases during a two-week time span.
