## COVID-19 Exposure Notice

Dear Parents and/or Guardians:

This letter is to inform you that your child, NAME, was in close contact with a person who tested positive for COVID-19 while that person was infectious. Your child was exposed to the virus on DATE at SCHOOL NAME/CLASS ROOM.

COVID-19 is caused by a new Coronavirus that was first identified in late 2019. It is spread from person to person through droplets produced by coughing or sneezing. It causes mild symptoms in most people but in some people it can cause more severe illness, such as pneumonia.

COVID-19 can cause a variety of symptoms. Some COVID-19 symptoms can seem like a common cold, others are more severe, and sometimes people have no symptoms. Symptoms to watch for are cough, shortness of breath, fever, chills, runny nose, sore throat, body aches, headache, loss of smell, loss of taste, fatigue, abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea.

Your child will need to do a home quarantine for 14 days from (Exposure DATE), which is the last time they were in contact with the positive case. The last day of their quarantine will be DATE, so they can return to school on DATE as long as they are healthy. During the quarantine period they need to stay home from school and not go out into the community. They should limit interactions with other household members just in case they become ill. Monitor your child for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19. If they become ill, you should call the Agnesian COVID clinic at **844-225-0147** to get them tested. A negative COVID test will not reduce the length of time required for the quarantine period or allow your child to return to school sooner. If your child does not start experiencing symptoms during their quarantine period, we do not recommend getting them tested.

This quarantine only applies to your child who had close contact with someone who tested positive for Covid-19, the other people in your household do not need to quarantine.
