





Fond du Lac County is a well-diversified, leading agricultural county in Wisconsin and ranks as the nation's 26th largest dairy county. Crops are primarily used to feed the county's 52,000 dairy cows. Soil types range from clays to loams and the limestone based, well-drained soils located throughout much of the county are ideal for growing high yields of alfalfa. The area averages about 32 inches of precipitation per year. The agricultural infrastructure in Fond du Lac County is solid. There are competitive markets for every major livestock and crop commodity. Additionally, there are numerous dealers for seeds, feeds, equipment, fertilizers, and most agricultural services (nutritionists, A.I. technicians, crop consultants, farm credit officers, etc.). 

An efficient and convenient crossroads of highway systems makes commerce to and from Minneapolis/St. Paul, La Crosse, Rochester, Dubuque, Madison and all points beyond, another unique advantage offered by Fond du Lac County. Fond du Lac County serves as a central location with excellent highway access to major markets in Green Bay (70 miles), Madison (70 miles), Milwaukee (60 miles), Chicago (150 miles) and Minneapolis (275 miles). U.S. Highway 41 is the major north/south route providing four lanes of traffic through the county. Highways 45 and 151 are additional north south routes with Hwy 151 recently expanding to four lanes between Fond du Lac and Madison. State Highways 23, 68, 67 and 103 provide east-west travel and highways 26, 44, 49, 149 and 175 provide north-south access to points throughout Fond du Lac County.

**INTRODUCTION**

Fond du Lac County has asked the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (“DATCP”) to certify a proposed comprehensively revised county farmland preservation plan pursuant to s. 91.16, Wis. Stats. DATCP has considered the request and adopts the following decision:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

- (1) DATCP is an agency of the State of Wisconsin, and is responsible for administering Wisconsin’s farmland preservation law under ch. 91, Wis. Stats., as repealed and recreated by 2009 Wis. Act 28.
- (2) Fond du Lac County is a county of the State of Wisconsin.
- (3) In order for a county and its residents to participate in the farmland preservation program, a county must have a state-certified farmland preservation plan. Among other things, the certified plan must clearly designate farmland preservation areas that the county plans to preserve for agricultural use.
- (4) Fond du Lac County has a state-certified farmland preservation plan that expires on December 31, 2012.
- (5) Under s. 91.16(8), Wis. Stats., the certification of a farmland preservation plan does not cover any subsequent plan revision (adopted after July 1, 2009) unless DATCP certifies that plan revision.
- (6) On August 29, 2012, DATCP received from Fond du Lac County a request to certify a comprehensively revised county farmland preservation plan under s. 91.16, Wis. Stats. The county submitted the application in the form required under s. 91.20, Wis. Stats. The application included the certifications required under s. 91.20(3), Wis. Stats.
- (7) Under s. 91.16(3)(a), Wis. Stats., DATCP may certify a county plan based on the county’s certification under s. 91.20(3), Wis. Stats., that the plan meets applicable certification standards under s. 91.18, Wis. Stats.
- (8) DATCP may certify a farmland preservation plan if the plan meets applicable statutory standards under s. 91.18, Wis. Stats. DATCP may certify based on the representations contained in the county’s application, but may conduct its own review and verification as it deems appropriate.
- (9) Under s. 91.10(2), Wis. Stats., the farmland preservation plan must be consistent with the county comprehensive plan if one exists. Fond du Lac County does not have a County Comprehensive Plan.
- (10) Under s. 91.16(2)(a), Wis. Stats., DATCP may certify a county farmland preservation plan for a specified period of up to 10 years. Under s. 91.16(6), Wis. Stats., DATCP may make its certification contingent upon the county adoption of the certified plan text and maps, in the form certified.

(11) Under s. 91.16(9), Wis. Stats., DATCP may withdraw its certification at any time if DATCP finds that the certified plan materially fails to meet applicable certification standards under s. 91.18, Wis. Stats.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

(1) Based on Fond du Lac County's certification that the attached county farmland preservation plan meets applicable certification requirements under s. 91.18, Wis. Stats., DATCP may certify that plan for up to 10 years.

(2) DATCP may make its certification contingent upon the county adoption of the certified plan text and maps, in the form certified.

(3) Certification does not apply to plan amendments made after the certification date, unless DATCP certifies those amendments.

(4) DATCP may withdraw its certification at any time if DATCP finds that the certified plan text and maps materially fail to meet applicable certification standards under s. 91.18, Wis. Stats.

### ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

(1) The attached Fond du Lac County Farmland Preservation Plan text and maps (November 6, 2012) are hereby certified under s. 91.16, Wis. Stats., and contingent upon county adoption of the plan, in the form certified, before December 31, 2013.

(2) The certified farmland preservation plan area for Fond du Lac County is titled "Farmland Preservation Areas (Areas of Agricultural Use and Agriculture Related Use).

(3) This order takes effect on the date on which the county adoption of the plan text and maps, in the form submitted, takes effect.

(4) This certification expires at the end of the day on December 31, 2022.
